Smoking

The Royal International Convention Centre is non-smoking venue. Therefore, smoking is not permitted within the confines of the venue this includes the loading dock, the lower level car park and all fire exit pathways.

Smoking is only permitted outside the venue on The Plaza in the designated smoking location. Please follow directional signage to this area.

Evacuation

In the event of an emergency or smoke alarm activation, the in house alarm system will sound. This is a two stage alarm. The first tone you will hear is the alert tone which is a repetitive beeping tone. Stay calm, and wait for further directions from Convention Centre staff and Emergency Wardens.

IF an evacuation is required, a second tone will sound which sounds like a high pitched whooping tone. At this point you will need to make your way directly to the nearest emergency exit and follow directions from Convention Centre Staff and Emergency Wardens to the nearest assembly point. Do Not use the lift.
